APPLICATION:

- Apply by mop, hi-pressure or autoscrubber in dilutions above with clean water.
- For polymer removal allow approximately 2 - 3 minutes for the product to soften the waxes and polymers.
- Remove with a single disc or autoscrubber or manually with a soft broom.
- Remove all suspended residues with a wet extraction machine and rinse well with water.
- It is recommended that a defoaming agent be used with wet extraction equipment.
- Available in High foaming & Low foaming format.

SAFETY:

- Use eye protection, rubber gloves and safety shoes.
- Use respiratory masks with organic filters in enclosed areas.
- Rinse eyes and skin with copious amounts of clean water.
- Apply fatty based cream to affected skin.
- Do not ingest.
- Highly alkaline.
- Does not contain ammonia.
